



Junior Day Camp Language course

Age range and language levels

The Junior Day Camp is for children from 6 - 9 years old, who are NOT native speakers of the chosen language (Englisch, German or French). Children from beginner to intermediate level (A0, A1, B1,-B2) can join the Junior Day Camp classes, which also accommodate those who have not yet learnt to read and write.

Language classes - fun whilst learning

Children learn by using the chosen language in fun activities with their classmates, working in pairs and groups. Language is introduced through songs, books, films and games, all in a very safe and relaxed, yet organised and supervised environment. Classes are small, allowing plenty of individual attention. The classes are NOT to teach the children how to read and write, though in the higher class, there may be reading and writing activities where appropriate.

Aims of the classes

The most important aspect of the class is to help the children to feel comfortable using their chosen language, thus enhancing their self-confidence. The children are from different areas and countries, and so they can learn about different cultures and habits, whilst making new friends. Our dedicated team will motivate the children to use the language throughout the whole day camp.
